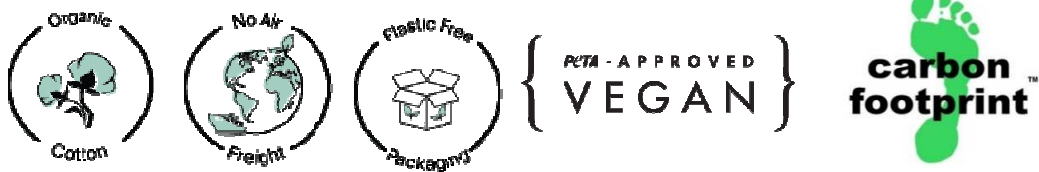

Why use Organic Cotton?

Organic Cotton is grown using only natural fertilisers and non genetically modified seeds



Waste water is treated so no contamination is released into the environment



Finishing leaves no dye, bleach or chemical residue

Ensures:

- Farmers can reuse seeds and grow mixed crops

Reduces:

- Water usage: Organic farming methods

- Farmers can reuse seeds and grow mixed crops helping feed their families and reduce financial risk
- Workers in the supply chain are not exposed to any harmful chemicals or residues
- All factories are routinely inspected to ensure no forced or child labour

- water waste: Organic farming methods maintain soil quality meaning rain water is held in the soil so less water is needed
- The use of chemicals deemed harmful by the World Trade Organisation

Did you know?

Traditional cotton production uses 10% of world pesticides and 25% of world insecticides, strong chemical agents that pollute the ecosystem.
